Welcome to CPE in the Wine Country!

Parking - please park into the fencing (with bumper facing the fence) around perimeter of property and alongside the dirt slope. Pull in forward and **stay as close as you can to the person next to you allowing for dogs/people to get in and out as easily as possible**. All parking is on dirt. Be patient and allow time to park and unload, if it is not very warm you may find it easy to work out of your vehicle. If it is warm do not leave dogs unattended in a vehicle unless they are being cooled by a fan or other device. If parking is full on top level; follow the dirt path around the back and there is plenty of open space to park past the arena. Do not block any driveways!

Set up & crating – Crating area and parking area is shared so be aware of this and do not let your dogs run loose. It is difficult to stake your EZ ups down, as the surface is decomposed granite and can be rather hard, we do get a breeze around 2PM everyday, so if you have weights for your EZ ups that would be best! Due to the rain forecast on Thursday and Friday we will be late in setting up so you may come on Friday afternoon **after 5:00 PM** to set up your area until dark; however, be aware that we are out in the country and although theft from a human is highly unlikely, other critters may find your set-up cozy, so leave as little on the ground as possible. ☺ Set up close to your neighbours. The car row closest to the set up area is welcome to work out of the back of their vehicles and set up ezups where they park. Be aware of that Sunday morning when you come in so as to not park in someone's set-up area.

Volunteers - Volunteer's are not only appreciated, but are necessary to conduct a smooth running show. Please see my volunteer coordinator Linda Limkemann when you arrive to sign up to help, or you can contact Cindy at cinross@verizon.net before the show. Volunteers will be generously rewarded with lunches and raffle tickets for a Workers gift raffle on Saturday and free run drawing on Sunday!

Food – Breakfast items will be available in the morning **for all exhibitors** as well as Water and Sodas throughout the day. Lunch is available for a \$6 donation. All workers will be provided with a free lunch. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a 15 minute driving distance (one way). If you would like to purchase a lunch we will have extra food on hand; **but an RSVP would be greatly appreciated! We will be serving Chicken Tacos with a salad and dessert on Saturday, and Cheesy Pasta with a salad and dessert on Sunday.**



Restrooms – There will be portable restrooms for your convenience

Walking Paths: You are welcome to walk on our property while you are waiting for your runs. You will see well designated paths that my husband has cleared that are really nice to walk on. ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES!! No running loose through the groves as we DO get rattlers here, and spring is here -so that means babies could be out. We try to keep the area as cleared as possible, but you just never know. Use precaution and common sense.

Ring Plan - Please be aware that the order of classes or jump heights may be rearranged on the day to ensure efficient running of the show. We will do our best to post and announce any changes, but ultimately it is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of what is happening in the ring.

Saturday: (Small to Tall)

Full House – All Levels Combined by Jump Height

Standard Round 1 then immediately Round 2: Levels 4-C, 4-C, 3, 3, 2, 2,1, 1

Wildcard – Levels 3 through C, 1 through 2

Snooker – Levels 3 through C, 1 through 2

Sunday: (Tall to Small)

Colors – 3 through C, 1 through 2

Standard Round 1 then immediately Round 2: Levels 4-C, 4-C, 3-2, 3-2,1, 1

Jackpot – All Levels combined

Jumpers – Levels 3 through C, 1 through 2

Directions:

From the North: I-15 South. Exit Rancho California Road, turn left go over freeway heading East. (Approx. 8 miles) Go through wine country; turn right on Glen Oaks Road (stop sign) drive to first stop sign(Approx. 2.5 miles) turn right on De Portola Road drive (approx. 1 mile) turn left at Via De Oro (Glen Oak Hills North entrance) **FIRST IMMEDIATE LEFT** is Los Ranchos Circle, turn left. My Home is on the left, long driveway, two large pillars, white fencing and lots of palm trees!

From the South: 1-15 North. Exit Rancho California Road, turn right at signal heading East. (Approx. 8 miles) Go through wine country; turn right on Glen Oaks Road (stop sign) drive to first stop sign(Approx. 2.5 miles) turn right on De Portola Road drive (approx. 1 mile) turn left at Via De Oro (Glen Oak Hills North entrance) **FIRST IMMEDIATE LEFT** is Los Ranchos Circle, turn left. Home is on the left, long driveway, two large pillars, white fencing and lots of palm trees!

From the 215 Freeway West: Exit Scott Road turn left over freeway heading South. Stay on Scott Road, it will change names several times (Washington, Borel, Rancho California) – do not turn until you come to Glen Oaks Road. (Approx. 15 miles +/-) then at the stop sign you will turn Left on to Glen Oaks Road. drive to first stop sign(Approx. 2.5 miles) turn right on De Portola Road drive (approx. 1 mile) turn left at Via De Oro (Glen Oak Hills North entrance) **FIRST IMMEDIATE LEFT** is Los Ranchos Circle, turn left. Home is on the left, long driveway, two large pillars, white fencing and lots of palm trees!
