ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE: All pre-entries for agility trial must be RECEIVED by **October 25, 2021** To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and **accompanied by the correct fees made payable to** *Jumpin' K-9's, Inc.* You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form). **NO DOG MAY RUN** without a registration form completed prior to their first run (registration form attached).

Move ups accepted until day of trial via email; day of trial move-ups also accepted.

Judging Schedule for Saturday will be sent out before day of show. Course Maps will be posted for you to take photos of.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE / RUNNING ORDER (subject to change)

Saturday: small to tall

Standard Rd. 1 (B, I, S), Call Direct & Send, Rekoons, Standard Rd. 2 (B, I, S) Full House (All Levels)

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height in each class and to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. **We offer Championship ribbons and bars!!** Please let us know in advance if you will possibly be getting your TACh at this event.

MEASURING & CHECK-IN: All dogs without a jump height card will need to be measured before the first class. **There will be obstacle familiarization each day.**

FEO: Unlimited FEO runs will be offered at this trial. <u>FEO runs are offered only to dogs entered in 1 scored class of the 2 day trial.</u> FEO (For Exhibition Only) Teams running FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times the standard course time in the ring. The dog may be on a leash as long as the handler is careful not to get it caught on any obstacles while in the ring. Teams may not repeat any contact obstacles (no training allowed) while running FEO. All rules for food and toy remain in effect same as non-FEO runs.



CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility — All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility —Dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs that have earned a title from another organization may "Fast Track" in this class.

Superior Agility —Dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class as are dogs that have Fast Tracked through the Beginner and Intermediate levels. (Dogs who have earned the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) are also eligible for this class.)

Games Classes

Games I— all dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II — only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III — only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Call, Direct and Send

Call, Direct and Send (CDS) is a numbered course that requires the team to solve three distance challenges: Call, Direct, and Send. CDS is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. ER7

Rekoons

Rekoons is Snooker played backwards. Rekoons is a two-part game. The opening sequence in Rekoons is to perform the numerical sequence 7 - 2. After completing #7 obstacle (or faulting an obstacle in the opening) the dog is directed to collect points by doing different combinations of red (jumps) and obstacles. *Rekoons* is scored Points, Then Time. ER2

Full House

Full House is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. *Full House* is scored Points, Less Penalty, Then Time. ER6

Judges briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings.



Fall Fun Run Specifics

The Fall Fun Run is a special event, like the Petit Prix. As a result, dogs are required to jump at their measured height as adjusted for any exemptions to which they are entitled. Also, no food or toys are allowed to be used in the ring.

Dogs that are measured 20"-22" must compete on standard agility equipment, jump 16" and will be scored at 20".

Beginner, Intermediate and Superior Handler dog teams may choose to either compete in the Fall fun Run or decide not to. You cannot double up. You will earn one qualifying leg for each class entered at your current level whether competeing in the Fall Fun Run or not.

Class Information:

The Fall Fun Run is a part of this trial. When you register, please indicate whether you wish to compete in the Fall Fun Run so that we have an accurate understanding of the participants and can prepare the runs and trial results correctly. It is not necessary to compete in the Fall Fun Run if you do not wish to do so. All Qualifying runs, regardless of whether you are competing in the Fall Fun Run will count towards regular TDAA Titles.

Beginner and Intermediate dogs may run in the Superior and Games 3 levels to earn legs at the Fall Fun Run at their respective levels. The scores for Beginner and Intermediate level dogs will only count toward the Fall Fun Run classes for this event at the Superior and Games 3 levels. TDAA will provide the overall Champion and Reserve Champion awards for all five scoring heights at the Superior and Games 3 level. TDAA will also provide a participation rosette for each handler.

TDAA Petit Prix 2022:

In 2022 the TDAA Petit Prix will be presented by Cloud Nine Training School for Dogs in Maple Grove, Minnesota on July 28th-31st. Kim and Dennis Vogel are our gracious host for this event.



ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. **NO DOG MAY RUN** without a registration form completed prior to their first run (registration form attached).

The following is a list of obstacles that will be used at this trial: All Contacts are rubber granules – teeter is calibrated for teacup.

A-Frame (lowered (4') 9' x 3' - molded slats) Teeter (lowered (16") 12' x 12" - no slats) Table (Standard 3' x 3' - 6" & 12" high) Weave Poles (24" spacing) Dogwalk (lowered (3') 12' x 12" Planks – molded slats) Tunnels (24" diameter) Tire Jump (24" diameter) Jump Wings (solid and woven panels) Jumps (4')

WARM-UPS:

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Other obstacles may or may not be included in the warm-up area. There will be obstacle familiarization at this trial and at the start of each trial day.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division.

- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 16" or less
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring over 20" but less than or equal to 22" at the withers

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules at www.k9tdaa.com for a complete description of height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Due to recent Covid-19 issues there will be a separate waiver that must be read and signed to participate at this event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required to be received before the first day of the trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25 for returned checks. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed. PayPal will be accepted and can be sent to cinross@verizon.net as friends as family any fees incurred you will be charged for those.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. If your entry is illegible the secretary will attempt to contact you. If unable to contact you the entry will be returned to you.
- Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in SCT in the Standard class and in the qualifying course time for games classes.



PLEASE READ!!!

This Trial will not run in the rain. If we cannot run this trial before it starts due to weather, we will cancel the trial as soon as we possibly can. If we have to finish short and cannot restart the trial there will be no refunds for unfinished runs. If for some reason the trial has to be cancelled after the closing date, we will do our best to reimburse as much as we can after expenses have been gone over. There is NO guarantee of a full refund.

For safety of the dogs and the humans; this trial will not run in rainy weather.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Program Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **You must submit a copy of title certificates for each dog.** Fast tracked dogs are not eligible for placement or title ribbons, but are eligible to receive Q ribbons.

Submit \$8.00 for each dog's fast track move-up request. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. If you have fast tracked before at a previous trial but have not moved up to the equivalent level based on titles earned through another organization, you may fast track at this trial by submitting the Fast Track Move Up request and fee.
